

Scholarship Criteria for the SSC at Texas A&M Scholarship

- Purpose:** The SSC Scholarship Fund awards scholarships to SSC employees and/or their children who are attending Texas A&M University based on demonstrated academic achievement, community service, and an express interest in pursuing their education.
- Criteria:** The students eligible for assistance must be current Texas A&M students or graduating high school seniors who reside in Texas and intend to continue their education at Texas A&M. Consideration will be given to academic achievement and the student's community service record. Students should submit a scholarship application on the form provided by SSC.
- Guidelines:** Scholarships will be awarded on an annual basis and disbursed in equal payments in August and January. Students must continue to attend classes and maintain no lower than a 3.0 grade-point average (or equivalent).
- Amount:** Each scholarship awarded will be a minimum of \$1,000 annually to be paid in two equal installments.
- Deadline:** The application deadline is **June 1st**. The deadline is the date after which applications will no longer be accepted. SSC uses the postmarked date to determine mailed entries.
- Renewal Process:** This scholarship is renewable. Previous scholarship recipients can re-apply.
